**THE TRUTH, JUSTICE AND RECONCILIATION
(AMENDMENT) ACT, 2013**

No. 44 of 2013

Date of Assent: 24th December, 2013

AN ACT of Parliament to amend the Truth, Justice and Reconciliation Act, 2008

ENACTED by the Parliament of Kenya, as follows—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Truth, Justice and Reconciliation (Amendment) Act, 2013.

Short title and commencement.

(2) This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 28th June, 2013.

2. The Truth, Justice and Reconciliation Act, 2008, in this Act referred to as “the principal Act”, is amended in section 2 by adding the words “and includes the Attorney-General” at the end of the definition of the word “Minister”.

Amendment of section 2 of No. 6 of 2008.

3. The principal Act is amended in subsection (4) of section 48 -

Amendment of section 48. No. 6 of 2008.

(a) by inserting the words “for consideration” immediately after the word “Parliament”;

(b) by deleting the word “Parliament” and substituting therefor the word “National Assembly”.

4. The principal Act is amended by deleting section 49 and substituting therefor the following new section—

Replacement of section 49 of No. 6 of 2008.

49. (1) The Minister shall, upon the consideration of the report of the Commission by the National Assembly, set in motion a mechanism to monitor the implementation of the report in accordance with recommendations of the National Assembly.

Implementation of Commissions Report.

(2) The Minister shall cause the reports of the Government on the implementation to be published in

the appropriate form for the public.

(3) Implementation of the report of the Commission shall commence immediately after consideration of the report by the National Assembly.

section 50 of

5. The principal Act is amended in section 50 by deleting the words "of receipt of the report of the Commission" appearing in subsection (1) and substituting therefor the words "after the commencement of the implementation under Section 49(3)".
