4. (1) There shall be established in the Township of Malaba a town council to be known as the Town Council of Malaba which shall consist of—

- (a) five elected councillors one of whom shall be elected from each of the five electoral areas specified in the Second Schedule; and
- (b) not more than one councillor to be nominated by the Minister under section 39 (1) (c) of the Act, who shall be a public officer.

LEGAL NOTICE No. 404

THE LAW SOCIETY OF KENYA ACT

(Cap. 18)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 27 of the Law Society of Kenya Act, the Council, with the approval of the Society by special resolution, makes the following Regulations:—

THE LAW SOCIETY OF KENYA (GENERAL) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1993

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Law Society of Kenya (General) (Amendment) Regulations, 1993, and shall come into operation on 1st January, 1994.

Sub. Leg.

2. The Law Society of Kenya (General) Regulations are amended as follows:

(a) by deleting regulation 3 and inserting the following—

3 (1) The annual subscription for membership of the society shall be—

(a) the sum of Sh. 7,000 in one year or the sum of Sh. 10,000 in two years in respect of practising advocates whose names have been on the Roll of Advocates for up to three years;

(b) the sum of Sh. 17,000 in one year or sum of Sh. 23,000 in two years in respect of practising advocates whose names have been on the Roll of Advocates for more than three years but less than five years;

(c) the sum of Sh. 23,250 in one year or the sum of Sh. 31,250 in two years in respect of practising advocates whose names have been on the Roll of Advocates for more than five years but less than ten years;

(d) the sum of Sh. 33,250 in one year in respect of practising advocates whose names have been on the Roll of Advocates for more than ten years;

(e) the sum of Sh. 31,000 payable in one year in respect of any advocate over the age of seventy years or any non-practising advocate; and

(f) the sum of Sh. 30,080 in one year in respect of non-advocates,

which subscription shall become due and payable on 1st January of every year.
