IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 16 of the Subordinate Courts (Separation and Maintenance) Act, the Chief Justice makes the following Rules:—

THE SUBORDINATE COURTS (SEPARATION AND  
MAINTENANCE) (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1982

1. These Rules may be cited as the Subordinate Courts (Separation and Maintenance) (Amendment) Rules, 1982, and shall come into operation on the 1st June, 1982.

2. The Subordinate Courts (Separation and Maintenance) Rules are amended by deleting rule 3 and substituting the following—

3. The fees payable in proceedings under the Act shall, unless remitted in whole or in part by a magistrate having jurisdiction, be—

	<i>Sh.</i>
On filing a complaint or application . . . . .	60
On taking out a witness summons . . . . .	10
On taking out any other summons . . . . .	20
For the service of each document on a party, witness or other person:	
(i) within two miles of the court issuing it . . . . .	10
(ii) beyond that distance up to ten miles . . . . .	20
(iii) beyond ten miles . . . . .	30
