

2. (1) The fees for a practising certificate issued to an advocate under section 27 of the Act shall be—

(a) the sum of three hundred and twenty shillings in respect of advocates who have been on the Roll of Advocates for five years or more; and

(b) the sum of one hundred and thirty shillings in respect of advocates who have not been on the Roll of Advocates for five years;

(2) The fees for a practising certificate shall be paid to the Society in accordance with the provisions of section 86 of the Act.

3. The Advocates (Practising Certificates) (Fees) Regulations, 1957, are revoked.

LEGAL NOTICE No. 86

## THE LAW SOCIETY OF KENYA ACT

(Cap. 18)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 27 of the Law Society of Kenya Act, the Council, with the approval of the Society by special resolution, makes the following Regulations:—

### THE LAW SOCIETY OF KENYA (GENERAL) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1984

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Law Society of Kenya (General) (Amendment) Regulations, 1984 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st January, 1984.

Sub. Leg.

2. The Law Society of Kenya (General) Regulations are amended—

(a) by deleting regulation 3 and substituting the following—

3. (1) The annual subscription for membership of the Society shall be—

(a) the sum of seven hundred and fifty shillings in respect

of advocates whose names have been on the Roll of Advocates for five years or more; and

(b) the sum of five hundred shillings in respect of non-practising advocates and practising advocates whose names have not been on the Roll of Advocates for five years; and

(c) the sum of eighty shillings in respect of non-advocates, which subscriptions shall become due and payable on the 1st January in every year.

(2) The annual subscription shall be paid to the Society by all members in accordance with the provisions of section 27 of the Advocates Act.

(b) in regulations 22, by deleting the full stop at the end and inserting "or in such other place in Kenya as the Council may from time to time decide."
