LEGAL NOTICE No. 97

THE REGULATION OF WAGES AND CONDITIONS OF
EMPLOYMENT ACT

(Cap. 229)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 11 of the Regulation of Wages and Conditions of Employment Act, the Minister for Labour makes the following Order:—

THE REGULATION OF WAGES (GENERAL) (AMENDMENT)
(No. 2) ORDER, 1987

1. This Order may be cited as the Regulation of Wages (General) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order, 1987 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 30th January, 1987.

2. The Regulation of Wages (General) Order, 1982 is amended— L.N. 120/1982.

(a) by deleting paragraph 5 (1) and inserting the following—

5. (1) The normal working week shall consist of not more than fifty-two hours of work spread over six days of the week.

(b) by deleting paragraph 6 (1) and inserting the following—

6. (1) Overtime shall be payable at the following rates—

(a) for time worked in excess of the normal number of hours per week at one and one-half times the normal hourly rate;

(b) for time worked on the employee's normal rest day or public holiday at twice the normal hourly rate.

(c) by deleting paragraph 7 and inserting the following—

Weekly
rest.

7. Every employee shall be entitled to one whole rest day in each week:

Provided that—

(i) an employer and his employee may, by mutual consent, agree to the deferment of the employee's rest day and the rest day so deferred may be taken by the employee on a subsequent day or may, subject to a maximum accumulation of fourteen such rest days at any one time, be accumulated and taken as leave with full pay in addition to the employee's entitlement to annual leave with full pay under paragraph 9;

- (ii) the weekly rest day of a person under the age of sixteen years shall not be so deferred.

(d) by deleting the Fifth Schedule.

Explanatory Note.—(This is not part of the order but is intended to indicate its general purpose.) The effect of this Order is to revoke the amendments made by the Regulation of Wages (General) (Amendment) Order, 1987 (L.N. 17/1987) and insert the provisions that were in existence on the date of commencement of that Order, that is 30th January, 1987.

THE CUSTOMS AND EXCISE ACT

(Cap. 472)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 138 (1) of the Customs and Excise Act, the Minister for Finance makes the following Order:—

THE CUSTOMS AND EXCISE (REMISSION) (No. 16) ORDER, 1987

1. This Order may be cited as Customs and Excise (Remission) (No. 16) Order, 1987 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st January, 1987.

2. The whole of the import duty payable in respect of 35 mm unexposed motion picture film imported between the 8th January, 1987 and the 15th June, 1987 by the Umbrella Films Limited, of the United Kingdom, for the shooting of the film "White Mischief", is remitted, but the appropriate rate of duty shall be payable if the 35 mm unexposed motion picture film is not re-exported upon the expiry of this Order.

1. This Order may be cited as Customs and Excise (Remission) (No. 17) Order, 1987 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st February, 1987 and shall expire on the 15th June, 1987.
