## THE CUSTOMS TARIFF ACT

(Cap. 472)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Customs Tariff Act, and in pursuance of a direction\* given under section 37 of the Interpretation and General Provisions Act, the Minister for Health and Housing hereby makes the following Order:—

## THE CUSTOMS TARIFF (REMISSION) (No. 10) ORDER, 1964

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs Tariff (Remission) (No. 10) Order, 1964.

2. The whole of the import duties and suspended duties payable on the goods specified in the Schedule to this Order are hereby remitted.

3. The Customs Tariff (Remission) (No. 7) Order, 1964, is hereby revoked. L.N. 206/1964.

## SCHEDULE

Consignments of bona fide gifts, the duty on which would exceed one thousand shillings, which the Minister is satisfied are consigned to or imported for free distribution among poor or needy persons or for use in medical treatment or rehabilitation work in charitable institutions.
