COLLECTION OF UNION DUES

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 48(2) of the Labour Relations Act, 2007, the Cabinet Secretary for Labour and East African Affairs makes the following Order—

THE DOCK WORKERS UNION (COLLECTION OF UNION DUES)  
ORDER, 2016

1. This Order may be cited as the Dock Workers Union (Collection of Union Dues) Order, 2016.
2. An employer who employs not less than five members of the Dock Workers Union shall—
  - (a) deduct on a monthly basis, the sum specified in the Schedule in respect of union dues from the wages of an employee who has subscribed to be a member of that union;
  - (b) pay within ten days of the date of deduction, the total sums deducted under paragraph (a) by crossed cheque, made payable to the Dock Workers Union's Account No. 16-1093-734, Barclays Bank of Kenya, Nkurumah Road Branch, Mombasa;
  - (c) notify the Dock Workers Union, in writing, within one month of all payments together with a full Schedule of the paid up members;
  - (d) make written returns to the Registrar of Trade Unions within one month of making all the payments to the Dock Workers Union.
3. The Collection of Trade Union Dues Order, 2012\*, is hereby revoked.

SCHEDULE

A sum equal to two per centum from each member's basic wage subject to a maximum of one thousand two hundred Kenya Shillings per month.
