## THE STAMP DUTY ACT

(Cap. 480)

## THE PRISONS ACT

(Cap. 90)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 24 of the Prisons Act and in pursuance of a delegation\* made under section 38 (1) of the Interpretation and General Provisions Act, the Permanent Secretary, Vice-President's Office and Ministry of Home Affairs hereby declares that area situated approximately two miles north-east of Naivasha Township in the Nakuru District, Rift Valley Province, on the right-hand side of Naivasha Kinangop Road and comprising of one hundred and fifty-four acres, having the existing Somali Settlement immediately to the left-hand side, which has a gradual slope of 6,346 feet to 6,390 feet rising steeply to 6,450 feet from this point, to be a prison for the purposes of the Act.
