NOTICE OF EXCEPTION NO. 1/1969—STEAM BOILERS KNOWN
AS VACOMATIC BOILING PANS

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 40 of the Factories Act, the Chief Inspector of Factories hereby excepts the steam boilers specified in the first column of the Schedule to this Notice from the requirements of section 37 of the Act specified in the second column of the said Schedule, subject however to the conditions and limitations set out in the third column of the said Schedule.

Steam boilers known as "Vacomatic Boiling Pans", manufactured by James Stott & Co. (Engineers) Ltd., Vernon Works, Rayton, Near Oldham, England, being either externally fired or internally heated by electric immersion heaters.	Subsection (2) (a) (i)	Each pan shall have attached to it a bursting disc which shall be so designed as to prevent the pan being worked at a greater pressure than the maximum permissible working pressure and such bursting disc shall be renewed at intervals not exceeding 5 years.
	Subsections (2) (a) (iv) and (2) (c)	The manufacturer's instructions for working the pan shall be affixed to a placard and prominently displayed near the working place at the pan.
