## THE PUBLIC FEES ACT

(Cap. 424)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 2 of the Public Fees Act, the Minister of State for Immigration and Registration of Persons makes the following Regulations—

## PUBLIC FEES (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2006

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Public Fees (Amendment) Regulations, 2006 and shall come into operation on 1st January, 2007.
- 2. The Public Fees Regulations in these Regulations LN 74/1999, referred to as "the principal Regulations" are amended by deleting Regulation 2 and substituting the following new Regulation therefor—
  - "2(i) The fees for issue of passport shall be—
  - (a) three thousand shillings for a thirty-two page passport;
  - (b) four thousand five hundred shillings for a forty-eight page passport;
  - (c) six thousand shillings for a diplomatic passport;
  - (d) three thousand shillings for a service passport;
  - (e) nine hundred shillings for the East African passport.

- (ii) A passport issued shall be valid for a period of ten years and shall not be renewable."
- 3. Regulation 3 of the principal Regulations is amended by—
  - (a) deleting the words "two thousand shillings" in subparagraph (a) and substituting the words "three thousand shillings" therefor.
  - (b) deleting sub-paragraph (b) and substituting the following new subparagraph therefor—
  - "(b) the certificate of identity (CIN) issued shall not be renewable."
- 4. Regulation 4 of the principal Regulations is amended by deleting the words "eight hundred shillings" and substituting the words "three hundred shillings" therefor.
