LEGAL NOTICE NO. 235

THE KENYA INDEPENDENCE ORDER IN COUNCIL 1963

(L.N. 718 of 1963)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 4 (4) of the Kenya Independence Order in Council, 1963, the Governor-General hereby makes the following Order:—

THE KENYA (AMENDMENT OF LAWS) (PROMISSORY OATHS) ORDER, 1964

1. This Order may be cited as the Kenya (Amendment of Laws) (Promissory Oaths) Order, 1964.

Citation.

2. Section 2 of the Promissory Oaths Act (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act) is amended by—

Amendment of section 2 of Cap. 100.

- (a) inserting the words "or assumes the functions of" immediately after the words "or to act in" which appear in line 3;
- (b) inserting the words "or on the assumption of the functions of" immediately after the words "or to act in" which appear in line 2 of the proviso;
- (c) inserting the words "or subsequently again assumes the functions of" immediately after the words "or to act in" which appear in line 6 of the proviso; and
- (d) inserting the words "or assumption of the functions of" immediately after the words "or to act in" which appear in lines 8 and 9 of the proviso.

3. The First Schedule to the principal Act is amended by deleting the whole of the first item which relates to the Governor-General, the Deputy Governor-General, and a person designated to act as Governor-General, and by substituting the item following:—

<i>Person required to take oath</i>	<i>Person before whom oath to be taken</i>	<i>Oath</i>
Governor-General	The Chief Justice, or where the Chief Justice is the person required to take the Oaths, a Judge.	Oath of Allegiance Oath of Due Execution of Office.
