NOTICE OF EXCEPTION No. 3 (GENERAL)

STEAM BOILERS—DOMESTIC PRESSURE COOKERS

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 40 of the Factories Ordinance, 1950, the Chief Inspector of Factories hereby exempts from the requirements of section 37 of the said Ordinance any domestic pressure cooker designed for operation at a steam pressure not exceeding 20 pounds per square inch and having a total internal volume not exceeding 5 imperial gallons:

Provided that any such domestic pressure cooker used in a factory shall comply in all respects with British Standard No. 1746 of 1951.
