**THE TRANSFER AND DELEGATION OF POWERS
ORDINANCE, 1955**
(No. 31 of 1955)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 2 of the Transfer and Delegation of Powers Ordinance, 1955, the Governor, with the approval of the Legislative Council, hereby makes the following Order:—

**THE TRANSFER OF POWERS (MAINTENANCE ORDERS
ENFORCEMENT ORDINANCE) ORDER, 1961**

1. This Order may be cited as the Transfer of Powers (Maintenance Orders Enforcement Ordinance) Order, 1961.

2. The exercise of the power, on being satisfied that reciprocal provisions have been made for the enforcement in certain possessions, protectorates and territories of maintenance orders made by courts in the Colony to extend the Maintenance Orders Enforcement Ordinance to any such possession, protectorate or territory, which power is conferred upon the Governor by section 10 of the said Ordinance, is hereby transferred to the Minister for the time being responsible for the matters in question; and for the purpose of carrying such transfer into effect the said section 10 is consequentially amended by substituting for the word "proclamation", which appears therein, the word "notice".

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 2 of the Transfer and Delegation of Powers Ordinance, 1955, the Governor, with the approval of the Legislative Council, hereby makes the following Order:—

THE TRANSFER OF POWERS (PENAL CODE) ORDER, 1961

1. This Order may be cited as the Transfer of Powers (Penal Code) Order, 1961.

2. The exercise of the power to give permission for the wearing of certain uniforms or any dress having the appearance or bearing any of the regimental or other distinctive marks of any such uniform, to give written permission to import, sell or possess for sale any such uniform or dress or the buttons or badges appropriate thereto, and to order that any uniform, dress, button, badge or other thing in respect of which an offence has been committed shall not be forfeited, which power is conferred upon the Governor by section 180 of the Penal Code, is hereby transferred to the Minister for the time being responsible for the matters in question.
