THE PUBLIC FEES ACT

(Cap. 424)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 2 of the Public
Fees Act, the Deputy Prime Minister and Minister for Finance makes
the following Regulations:—

THE PUBLIC FEES (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2009

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Public Fees
(Amendment) Regulations, 2009.

2. Regulation 11 of the Public Fees Regulations is amended by
inserting the words, "or an equivalent amount in other convertible
currency" immediately after the word, "dollars" wherever it occurs. L.N. 74/1999.
