## THE KENYA INDEPENDENCE (NORTH-EASTERN REGION) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1963

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Kenya Independence (North-Eastern Region) (Amendment) Regulations, 1963, and shall come into force on the 12th December 1963.

2. The Kenya (North-Eastern Region) Regulations, 1963, arc amended by deleting the word "Governor", wherever it appears in regulations 3, 5, 6 and 9 thereof, and substituting therefor the words "Governor-General acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister".

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 1 (2) of the Kenya Independence Order in Council 1966 and of all other powers thereunto enabling him, the Governor hereby makes the following Regulations:—

## THE KENYA INDEPENDENCE (AMENDMENT OF LAWS) (PROMISSORY OATHS) REGULATIONS, 1963

1. These Regulations may be pited as the Kenya Independence (Amendment of Laws) (Promissory Oaths) Regulations, 1963, and shall come into operation on the 2th Recember 1963:--

2. The Promissory Oaths Ordinance is amended by deleting the word "Governor" wherever it appears, and by substituting therefor the words "Governor-General".

3. On the particular occasion of the celebration of Kenya's Independence on the 12th December 1963, any of the oaths prescribed in the Second Schedule to the Promissory Oaths Ordinance may be taken either in the prescribed form or in a Swahili translation of the prescribed form.
