#### PART 1 - PRELIMINARY

# PART II - CUSTOMS AND EXCISE

Amendment of section 12 of Can 472

- 2. Section 12 (1) of the Customs and Excise Act is amended by deleting paragraph (g) and inserting the following-
  - (g) all dutiable goods and excisable goods on which duty has not been paid.
  - Section 16 of the Customs and Excise Act is amended by inserting blowing new subsection-
  - (3) Subject to subsection (2), where the ownership of goods entered in transit is changed by virtue of a court order or for any order gasons the new owner shall be deemed to have assumed the congation to have the goods re-exported within the prescribed period.
