**AN ACT TO ALLOW AND CONFIRM CERTAIN  
EXPENDITURE IN RESPECT OF THE ORGANIZA-  
TION, THE ASSEMBLY AND OF THE SERVICES  
OTHER THAN SELF-CONTAINED SERVICES THE  
ADMINISTRATION OF WHICH HAS BEEN TAKEN  
OVER BY THE ORGANIZATION FOR THE  
FINANCIAL YEAR ENDING 30TH JUNE, 1963**

*Date of commencement: 24th January, 1963*

ENACTED by the President of Tanganyika, the  
Governor-General of Uganda and the Governor of Kenya on  
behalf of the East African Common Services Organization  
with the advice and consent of the East African Central  
Legislative Assembly.

1. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Approp-  
riation (1962-1963) (Non-self-contained Services) Act, 1962.

Short title.

2. In this Act—

Interpretation.

“the Finance Committee” means the Committee described  
in paragraph (b) of Article 8 of the Constitution; and

“the General Fund” means the fund established under  
the provisions of paragraph 2 of Article 34 of the Constitution.

Expenditure.

3. The expenditure out of the General Fund to the amount of One hundred and seventy-one thousand, eight hundred and ninety pounds in respect of the Services specified in the Schedule during the financial year ending on the 30th June, 1963, and not provided for or not fully provided for by the Appropriation (1962-1963) (Non-self-contained Services) Act, 1962, is hereby allowed and confirmed.

Appropriation.

4. The moneys granted by this Act shall be appropriated for the purposes and services specified in the Schedule.

Authority to  
pay on warrant  
of Financial  
Secretary.

5. (1) The Accountant General of the Organization is hereby authorized, upon a warrant under the hand of the Financial Secretary, to pay out of the General Fund for the purposes and Services specified in the Schedule a sum not exceeding in the aggregate One hundred and seventy-one thousand, eight hundred and ninety for the financial year ending on the 30th June, 1963.

(2) Any warrant of the Financial Secretary issued under the provisions of subsection (1) of this section shall be subject to such restrictions, as to the amount of payment authorized thereby, as may be directed by the Finance Committee under the hand of the Chairman thereof.
