# THE FINANCE ACT, 1977

## An Aet of Parliament to amend the laws relating to various taxes and duties and for matters incidental thereto

ENACTED by the Parliament of Kenya, as follows:-

## Part I-Preliminary

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Finance Act, 1977.

Short title and commencement.
(2) The amendments effected by Part V of this Act shall come into effect on 1st January, 1978.
(3) Subject to subsection (2) of this section, the amendments effected by this Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on 17th June, 1977.

(2) In this section the expression "child" includes a step-child and a child who has been legally adopted but does not include any individual who is entitled to or receives, in his own right in any year of income, income exceeding eighteen hundred shillings.;
