1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Finance Act, 1979.
(2) Subject to subsection (3), the provisions of this Act shall be deemed to have come into force on the 8 th June, 1979.
(3) Paragraphs $(d),(\rho),(f)$ and $(g)$ of section 5 shall come into force on the 1st January, 1980.

Part IU-Customs and Excise
