## AN ACT TO AMEND THE PENSIONS ACT IN CONNEXION WITH APPROVED RETIREMENT SCHEMES FOR CERTAIN OFFICERS AND FOR PURPOSES CONNECTED THEREWITH

*Date of commencement: 9th December, 1961*

ENACTED by the President of Tanganyika, the Governor-General of Uganda and the Governor of Kenya on behalf of the East African Common Services Organization with the advice and consent of the East African Central Legislative Assembly.

Short title and  
commencement.  
Cap. 9.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Pensions (Amendment) Act, 1962, and shall be read and construed as one with the Pensions Act, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act.

(2) This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 9th December, 1961.

2. Section 2 of the principal Act shall be amended, in subsection (1) thereof, by the addition of the following new definition—

““approved special retirement scheme” means a scheme of retirement, approved by the Authority, relating to any specified class of officer but does not include the scheme of retirement authorized by the East African Common Services Organization (Compensation and Retiring Benefits) Order in Council, 1961.”

3. Section 6 of the principal Act shall be amended by the substitution of a semi-colon for the colon at the end of paragraph (g) thereof and the insertion immediately thereafter of the following new paragraph—

“(h) on retirement in accordance with any approved special retirement scheme;”.

4. Section 8 of the principal Act shall be amended by the substitution of a semi-colon for the fullstop at the end of paragraph (b) thereof and the addition of the following new paragraph—

“(c) in accordance with the terms of any approved special retirement scheme.”.

5. Section 10 of the principal Act shall be amended by the addition of the following new subsection—

“(3) The provisions of this section shall not apply to any officer who is required to retire under the provisions of an approved special retirement scheme.”
