**AN ACT TO AMEND THE EAST AFRICAN CUSTOMS
MANAGEMENT ACT, 1962**

Date of commencement: 26th June, 1962

ENACTED by the Governor-General of Tanganyika, the Governor of Kenya and the Governor of Uganda on behalf of the East African Common Services Organization with the advice and consent of the East African Central Legislative Assembly:—

1. This Act may be cited as the East African Customs Management (Amendment) Act, 1962, and shall be read and construed as one with the East African Customs Management Act, 1952, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act. Short title.

2. Section 134 of the principal Act is hereby repealed and the following new section to be numbered 134 is substituted therefore:— Repeal and substitution of section 134 of principal Act.

“Persons entering or leaving Territories to answer questions concerning baggage. 134. Any person entering or leaving the Territories shall answer such questions as the proper officer may put to him with respect to his baggage and any article contained therein or carried with him.”

3. Subsection (1) of section 137 of the principal Act is hereby amended by the deletion of the commas and words “, not being below the rank of first grade,”. Amendment of section 137 of principal Act.
