AN ACT TO APPLY A SUM OF MONEY FOR THE EXPENDITURE OF THE EAST AFRICAN POSTS AND TELECOMMUNICATIONS ADMINISTRATION FOR THE FINANCIAL YEAR ENDING 31ST DECEMBER 1964

Date of Commencement: 1st January 1964

ENACTED by the President of Tanganyika, the President of Uganda and the Governor of Kenya on behalf of the East African Common Services Organization with the advice and consent of the East African Central Legislative Assembly.

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation (1964) (East African Posts and Telecommunications) Act, 1963, and shall come into operation on the 1st January 1964.

Short title and commencement.

2. In this Act—

“the Fund” means the East African Posts and Telecommunications Fund maintained under the provisions of paragraph I of Article 34 of the Constitution.

Interpretation.

3. The Fund is hereby charged with the sum of eleven million, seven hundred and fifty-three thousand, four hundred and sixty pounds towards the expenditure of the East African Posts and Telecommunications Administration for the financial year ending 31st December 1964.

4. The moneys granted by this Act shall be appropriated for the purposes and services specified in the Schedule.

5. The Chief Accountant of the East African Posts and Telecommunications Administration is hereby authorized to pay out of the Fund for the purposes and services specified in the Schedule, a sum not exceeding in the aggregate eleven million, seven hundred and fifty-three thousand, four hundred and sixty pounds for the financial year ending 31st December 1964.
