An Act of Parliament to make minor amendments to the statute law

ENACTED by the Parliament of Kenva, as follows: ---

Short title. 1. This Act may be cited as the Statute Law (Miscellaneous Amendments) Act. 1976.

2. (1) The several written laws specified in the first column of the Schedule to this Act are hereby amended, in relation to the provisions thereof specified in the second column of that Schedule, in the manner specified in relation thereto in the third column of that Schedule.

(2) The amendment to the Industrial Training Act shall Cap. 237. be deemed to have taken effect from 5th December, 1975.

(3) The amendment to the National Social Security Fund Cap. 258. Act shall take effect on such date as the Minister for Labour may, by notice in the Gazette, appoint.

(4) The amendment to the Constitutional Offices (Remu-Cap. 423. neration) Act shall be deemed to have taken effect from the various dates specified in that amendment.

(5) The amendments to the Foreign Investments Protec-Cap. 518. tion Act shall be deemed to have taken effect from 15th December, 1964.

(6) All the other amendments specified in the Schedule to this Act shall take effect from the date of the publication of this Act in the Gazette.
