**An Act of Parliament to amend the Constitutional Offices  
(Remuneration) Act**

ENACTED by the Parliament of Kenya, as follows:—

Short title  
and  
commencement.

**1.** (1) This Act may be cited as the Constitutional Offices (Remuneration) (Amendment) Act, 1986.

(2) Paragraph (b) of section 2 of this Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st July, 1985.

Amendment of  
the Schedule to  
Cap. 423.

**2.** The Schedule to the Constitutional Offices (Remuneration) Act, in this Act referred to the principal Act, is amended—

(a) by deleting the entry “Member, Electoral Commission...£500 per annum” and inserting the following—

Chairman, Electoral Commission	...	£5,000 per annum
Vice-Chairman, Electoral Commission	...	£3,500 per annum
Member, Electoral Commission	...	£2,500 per annum

(b) by deleting the entries “Judge of Appeal...Job Group R” and “Puisne Judge...Job Group Q” and substituting “Judge of Appeal...Job Group S” and “Puisne Judge...Job Group R”.

**3.** The principal Act is amended by inserting the following new section immediately after section 4—

Exemption  
from  
income  
tax.

**5.** All allowances payable to the holder of the offices specified in the first column of the Schedule

to this Act shall be exempt from income tax notwithstanding the provisions of any other written law relating to income tax.
