THE INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT (AMENDMENT) ACT 1967

An Act of Parliament to amend the Industrial Development Act by altering the title of the Corporation and giving the Minister certain powers, and to make other minor or consequential amendments to that Act and to other written laws

ENACTED by the Parliament of Kenya, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Industrial Development (Amendment) Act 1967.

Short title.

2. The Industrial Development Act, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act, is amended by substituting for the words "Industrial Development Corporation", wherever they appear therein, the words "Industrial and Commercial Development Corporation".

Amendment of Cap. 517.

3. The principal Act is amended by inserting immediately after section 8 thereof the new section following—

Insertion of new section in principal Act.

- Power of Minister to give directions.
- 8A. The Industrial and Commercial Development Corporation shall, in the exercise of its powers and in the performance of its duties under this Act or any other written law, act in accordance with any general or special directions that may be given to it by the Minister.

Amendment of other written laws.

4. Every other written law in which there appears a reference to the Industrial Development Corporation is amended by substituting for that reference a reference to the Industrial and Commercial Development Corporation.

5. The Industrial Development Corporation as established and constituted immediately before the coming into operation of this Act shall continue in being under the name and title of the Industrial and Commercial Development Corporation as though established and constituted in accordance with the principal Act as amended by this Act.
