**AN ACT TO ALLOW AND CONFIRM CERTAIN
EXPENDITURE INCURRED IN RESPECT OF THE
EAST AFRICAN RAILWAYS AND HARBOURS
ADMINISTRATION FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31st
DECEMBER, 1960**

Date of Commencement: 30th November, 1961

WHEREAS the expenditure of one million, six hundred and twenty-two thousand, seven hundred and thirty-six pounds was necessarily incurred by the East African Railways and Harbours Administration, a self-contained service of the High Commission, on certain heads and subheads of the services of the Administration for the financial year ended 31st December, 1960, which expenditure was not provided for or not fully provided for in the Appropriation (East African Railways and Harbours) Act, 1960:

AND WHEREAS it is now requisite to make further provision for such expenditure:

NOW, THEREFORE, be it enacted by the East Africa High Commission, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly thereof, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation (1960) (East African Railways and Harbours) Act, 1961.

Interpretation.

2. In this Act, "the Fund" means the Railways and Harbours Fund maintained under the provisions of section 41 of the Order in Council.

Further expenditure for the financial year ended 31st December, 1960, authorized.

3. The expenditure out of the Fund to the amount of one million, six hundred and twenty-two thousand, seven hundred and thirty-six pounds, on the several heads and subheads of the services of the Administration specified in the
