

**THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY REMUNERATION
(AMENDMENT) ACT, 1994**

No. 9 of 1994

Date of Assent: 29th November, 1994

Date of Commencement: 1st July, 1994

An Act of Parliament to amend the National Assembly Remuneration Act to provide for increases in salaries and allowances and to provide for other additional allowances

ENACTED by the Parliament of Kenya as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the National Assembly Remuneration (Amendment) Act, 1994, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st July, 1994.

Short title and commencement.

2. Section 7 of the National Assembly Remuneration Act in this Act referred to as the “principal Act” is amended—

Amendment of section 7 of Cap. 5.

(a) by deleting the definition of “accommodation allowance” and inserting the following new definition—

“accommodation allowance” means an allowance payable to the person concerned—

(a) at the rate of £27,000 a year in respect of the Leader of the Official Opposition;

(b) at the rate of £22,000 a year in respect of the Government Deputy Chief Whip, the Official Opposition Whip and Members of the Chairmen’s Panel;

(c) at the rate of £20,000 a year in respect of all other Members of the National Assembly.

(b) in the definition of “constituency allowance”, by deleting “£2,664” and inserting “£3,120”;

(c) by deleting the definition of "house allowance" and inserting the following new definition—

"house allowance" means an allowance payable when no housing accommodation is provided by the Government for the person concerned—

(a) at the rate of £40,000 a year in respect of the Vice-President;

(b) at the rate of £30,000 a year in respect of the Speaker and Ministers;

(c) at the rate of £27,000 a year in respect of the Deputy Speaker and the Government Chief Whip;

(d) at the rate of £25,000 a year in respect of Assistant Ministers;

(d) by inserting after the definition of "house allowance" the following new definition—

"Nominated or Ex-officio Member allowance" means an allowance at the rate of £3,120 a year payable to a Nominated Member or an Ex-officio Member;

(e) in the definition of "sitting allowance", by deleting "£1,200" and inserting "£1,800"

3. The First Schedule to the principal Act is repealed and replaced by the following new Schedule—

4. The Second Schedule to the principal Act is repealed and replaced by the following—

1. Every Member of the National Assembly other than the Speaker, the Deputy Speaker, the Vice-President, other Ministers, and Assistant Ministers.	<p>A. Mileage allowance in respect of any journey made in Kenya for the purpose of attending—</p> <p>(a) a sitting of the National Assembly at which the Member attends; or</p> <p>(b) a meeting of any committee of the National Assembly which the Member attends; or</p> <p>(c) a meeting of any other committee, board or other body which the member attends, if the Member is also a Member of such committee, board or other body by virtue of a requirement in the constitution thereof that a Member of the National Assembly be included in the composition thereof whether as an individual Member of the National Assembly or as representing any organization or group of Members of the National Assembly; or</p> <p>(d) a meeting of any organization or group of Members of the National Assembly which is not less in number than the number of Members which constitutes a quorum of the Assembly and for the purpose of discussing any business before or to come before the National Assembly, and the Member is present at the meeting:</p> <p>Provided that—</p> <p>(i) mileage allowance shall not be paid to any Member of the National Assembly more than once in respect of any one day; and</p> <p>(ii) mileage allowance in respect of attendance at any meeting referred to in paragraph (d) shall not be paid in respect of more than twenty-eight attendances in any one year.</p> <p>B. Mileage allowance in respect of any journey made in Kenya by a Member between Nairobi and his home and his electoral area or the area which he represents on or in connection with the business of the National Assembly.</p>

2. The Deputy Speaker, the Vice-President, other Ministers, and Assistant Ministers.	Mileage allowance in respect of any journeys, not exceeding fifty-two in any one year, made outside Nairobi in connection with the business of the National Assembly or in connection with other special business not coming within the normal business of the the National Assembly or his Ministry, as the case may be.
