IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 138 (1) and (2) (c) of the Customs and Excise Act, the Minister for Finance makes the following Order:—

**THE CUSTOMS AND EXCISE (REMISSION)**

**(No. 8) ORDER, 1995**

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs and Excise (Remission) (No. 8) Order, 1995, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 23rd September, 1994, and shall, unless earlier revoked, expire on the 31st December, 1994.

2. The whole of the import duty payable in respect of 1,443 metric tons of sorghum donated to World Food Programme from the United Nations for free distribution in relief work, is remitted.
