LEGAL NOTICE No. 2

THE KENYA INDEPENDENCE ORDER IN COUNCIL 1963  
(L.N. 718 of 1963)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 4 (4) of the Kenya Independence Order in Council 1963, the Governor-General hereby makes the following Order:—

THE KENYA (AMENDMENT OF LAWS) (WRITTEN LAWS)  
ORDER, 1963

1. This Order may be cited as the Kenya (Amendment of Laws) (Written Laws) Order, 1963, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 12th December 1963.

2. Every written law which contains the word "Ordinance" (meaning an Ordinance of Kenya) is amended by substituting for the word "Ordinance", wherever it appears therein and has that meaning, the word "Act".
