

- (b) aircraft being used for Government ceremonial purposes;
- (c) aircraft belonging to the United Nations Organization;
- (d) aircraft on charter to the United Nations Organization in cases where the benefit of the exemption from fees will accrue to that Organization and not to the company supplying the aircraft;
- (e) aircraft chartered by the Kenya Police Air Wing when on police duty;
- (f) any other aircraft which the Minister may by notice in the Gazette exempt from payment of fees;
- (g) any particular landing or take-off which the Minister may in writing exempt from the payment of such fees.

24. The Minister may exempt any person from the payment of the whole or any part of the fees payable thereunder in any case in which in his opinion payment of the fees would cause undue hardship.

Legal Provisions

25. The use of aerodromes specified in the First Schedule shall be made on condition that no claim shall be made against the Government or any of its officers or servants for loss or damage from the use of the aerodromes or their facilities through act of God, war, civil commotion, riot, looting, labour disputes involving complete or partial stoppage of work, restrictive practices or strikes threatened or actual, explosion, failure of machinery or plant, negligence, fire or any other cause whatsoever.
