LEGAL NOTICE NO. 39

THE PENSIONS ACT

(Cap. 189)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 3 (2) of the Pensions Act, I, Daniel Toroitich arap Moi, President and Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces of the Republic of Kenya, make the following Regulations:—

THE PENSIONS (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1982

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Pensions (Amendment) Regulations, 1982.

2. (1) The amendments contained in regulation 3 (a) (i), 3 (c) (i) and 3 (d) of these Regulations shall take effect from the date of their publication.

(2) The amendments contained in regulation 3 (a) (ii), 3 (b), 3 (c) (ii) and 3 (e) of these Regulations shall be deemed to have taken effect from the 1st July, 1977.

3. The Pensions Regulations are amended—

(a) in regulation 4 by deleting—

(i) the expression “six-hundredth” and substituting “five-hundredth”; and

(ii) the full stop at the end and substituting the expression “, but no pension commencing after the 1st July, 1977, shall be less than sixty pounds per annum.”;

(b) in regulation 9 (1) by deleting the full stop at the end and substituting the expression “, but no pension commencing after the 1st July, 1977, shall be less than sixty pounds per annum.”;

(c) in regulation 10 (1) by deleting—

(i) the expression “six-hundredth” and substituting “five-hundredth”;

(ii) the full stop at the end and substituting the expression “, but no pension commencing after the 1st July, 1977, shall be less than sixty pounds per annum.”;

(d) in regulation 27 by deleting the expression “twelve and one half” and substituting “fifteen”; and

(e) in regulation 28 by deleting paragraph (3) and substituting the following—

(3) An officer who has been granted a gratuity under paragraph (1), who has been in the public service for not less than thirty years and whose salary on retirement is not more than the maximum salary payable for the time being to officers serving in Job Group B, or such other amount as the President may declare for the purposes of this paragraph, may, in addition to that gratuity, be granted an annual allowance of one thousand two hundred shillings, or, if he has had other public service, an annual allowance as bears the same proportion to an annual allowance of one thousand two hundred shillings as his service under the Government bears to his total public service.

LEGAL NOTICE NO. 40

THE WEIGHTS AND MEASURES ACT

(Cap. 513)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 46 of the Weights and Measures Act, the Minister for Commerce makes the following Rules:—

THE WEIGHTS AND MEASURES (SALE AND LABELLING OF GOODS) (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1982

1. These Rules may be cited as the Weights and Measures (Sale and Labelling of Goods) (Amendment) Rules, 1982.

2. The Weights and Measures (Sale and Labelling of Goods) Rules, are amended—

(a) by inserting in appropriate alphabetical sequence the following new definitions in rule 2—

“net quantity” means the quantity of a product contained in any package or group of packages;
